



# Tax Updates

## 2006 GOVERNMENT SUPPORTED NON PROFIT EXEMPT AGENCIES

Each year non-profit agencies may apply to the City and Borough of Sitka for sales tax exemption status. In order to qualify, they must provide proof that they are at least eighty percent (80%) government supported. Upon approval, the organization is issued a tax exemption number that they must provide in order to not have to pay sales tax on their purchases of goods and/or services at your business.

On the back side of this newsletter are those agencies who have applied and been approved for sales tax exemption status for 2006.

### REMINDER

The sales tax rate is 6% during the months of April, May, June, July, August, and September. Rentals of Real Property for thirty or more consecutive days remain at 5% (SGC 4.09.120). Bed tax remains at 6%.
