

Per SGC 11.58.010, Section 3 and Section 4.d of the Rules and Regulations for Operation of Air Terminals shall govern use of the airport by taxis, limousines, and buses including fees for such use.

Excerpt from Rules and Regulations for Operation of Air Terminals:

Section 3.C. GENERAL RULES: TAXICABS

- (1) No person shall operate any taxicab or other vehicle carrying passengers for hire from the airport unless he or she is the holder of an appropriate permit issued by the Municipality.*
- (2) Except as otherwise permitted by the Airport Manager, no person shall park at the airport, any taxicab or other vehicle used for the purpose of carrying passengers for hire, except for the purpose of discharging passengers, unless he or she is the holder of an appropriate permit issued by the Assembly.*
- (3) No person shall, within the boundary of the air terminals, solicit or invite persons to ride in any taxicab or other vehicle used for the purpose of carrying passengers for hire, by driving slowly past loading entrances to airport buildings, by committing other acts, or by uttering words which are calculated to induce persons to engage such taxicab or other vehicle, unless such activity is carried on with the approval of the Airport Manager and under such terms as he may prescribe.*

Section 4.D. FEES AND CHARGES/TAXIS, LIMOUSINES, BUSES. Per originating trip at the airport.

Per SGC 11.58.020.B., Failure to pay the monthly fee shall result in forfeiture of the violating company's permit for one year.

Per SGC 11.58.020.A., Operation of "for hire" vehicles at the Sitka Airport without a permit is a violation which shall be punished by a five-hundred-dollar fine.
