PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

Harrigan Centennial Hall (HCH) will close August 1, 2015 until December 2016 for a major remodel.

The City and Borough of Sitka (CBS) has executed an agreement with Shee Atik'a Holdings Alice Island, LLC to lease three office spaces at 601 Alice Loop Road (formerly Mt. Edgecumbe Preschool). This will provide an office space for the HCH staff and accommodate the City Commission meetings. All Commission meetings will be held at this location during their regular scheduled times, with the exception of the Police and Fire Commission which will take place at the Fire Department. The CBS also welcomes non-profit meetings on a first come first serve basis as space is available.

The Assembly meetings will be held at the University of Alaska Southeast in the Lecture Hall, Room 229, at the regular scheduled times.

Additionally, a visitor's booth will be located in the HCH eastern plaza parking lot area; staffed to welcome the community and visitors and distribute tourist attraction material. To accommodate the arrival of cruise ship passengers for the remainder of the season, tendering will be directed to the O'Connell Lightering Facility.

The HCH Staff thanks all the businesses and organizations that have offered alternative locations so events will continue to take place during this transition period.
