The City and Borough of Sitka is an equal opportunity employer.

“A. It shall be a prohibited discriminatory employment practice: 1. ADA EMPLOYMENT AND PROGRAM PROHIBITIONS

Title I of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 prohibits discrimination in employment on the basis of disability.

Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability in the programs and activities operated by the City and Borough of Sitka. This prohibition extends to admission and participation in the programs, services and activities of the City and Borough.
